INTRODUCTION

This award will be presented annually to one recipient, selected through a nomination and evaluation process.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO BE NOMINATED

The candidate must have:

1. At least 10 years certified experience teaching music in a public and/or private school.
2. Service to WSMA (adjudicator, committee member) and/or WMEA (council member, conference involvement).

Nominations are for individual teachers only, not groups.

NOMINATION PROCESS

Anyone is welcome to nominate a teacher for the Wisconsin Award for Excellence in Teaching Music. Three people with different relationships (student, parent, administrator, colleague, community member, etc.) with the candidate each need to complete the enclosed Nomination Form. In addition, the candidate must complete and submit the Candidate's Form. All nomination forms must be sent to WSMA/WMEA postmarked on or before **March 31, 2016**.

AWARD REVIEW PROCESS

All award nomination forms will be reviewed by a committee made up of members of the WSMA Board of Directors, the WMEA Executive Board, WSMA staff, and others. Award recipients will be announced in September. Awards will be presented at an event of the candidate's choosing (school concert, WSMA Concert Festival, or another suitable occasion).
