GENERAL INFORMATION

Headquarters

Festival Headquarters is located in the Bonaventure Hall Conference Center.

Schedules

Wisconsin School Music Association (WSMA) created the schedule for this Festival and did its very best to honor emergency time requests and avoid conflicts, whenever possible. If conflicts remain, the largest group from within the same school should take priority. Please inform room monitors if delays are anticipated. Directors may switch event performance times within their own school's entries, scheduled in the same room, by notifying the room monitor, but it is NOT permissible to change rooms.

Printed schedules will not be available at the information tables. Please print your schedules in advance of the festival, using the schedule pdf file provided on the WSMA website (www.wsmamusic.org).

Parking

After unloading, buses should park in Lot 11, the first parking lot on the right after entering the campus from Port Washington Road. Judges, teachers, performers, and their families may park in any of the campus lots.

Results Posting

Unofficial results will be posted outside of Festival Headquarters, approximately every half hour, beginning at 9 a.m. Results will also be posted within 48 hours on the WSMA website (wsmamusic.org). Directors may pick up completed adjudicator forms, in the Festival Headquarters, after the last results for the school have been posted. Envelopes not retrieved will be mailed directly to the school the week after the Festival.

Warm-Up Rooms

Do not leave instruments or other belongings unattended in warm-up rooms, hallways, or performance sites. Participants are responsible for their own belongings. Neither music stands or pianos will be provided in warm-up rooms.
