

# **2021 WSMA State Honors Music Project Health & Safety Requirements for Participation**

*As of September 22, 2021*

2021 WSMA State Honors Music Project staff, student participants, and concert performance attendees will need to follow the health and safety rules established by all venues and hotels in order to participate in this year's honors concert rehearsals and performances. Public Health Madison Dane County (PHMDC) has a current [face masking order](#) that expires October 8, 2021 so note our information is subject to change leading up to the event.

## **GENERAL EXPECTATIONS**

- Participants must wear a face mask that covers nose and mouth when indoors at all locations.
- PHMDC has exemptions when actively eating, drinking, and sleeping.
- Participants must wear a face mask when on bus transportation.
- Participants will be required to show proof of full vaccination OR a negative COVID-19 test from within 48 hours at registration.

*\*Note: Requirement for negative COVID-19 test timing of 48 hours is due to Overture Center and Verona Area High School requiring proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test result from within 72 hours prior to the honors performance.*

## **PROOF OF VACCINATION**

All participants and audience members must be fully vaccinated or show proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test. A participant vaccinated against COVID-19 by a two-dose mRNA vaccine (such as Moderna or Pfizer) or a single dose vaccine (such as Johnson & Johnson) is considered “fully vaccinated” two weeks after the final dose of vaccine (the second dose for a two-dose regimen or the single dose for a single-dose regimen). Those with documentation indicating they received AstraZeneca in a vaccine trial will also be considered immunized. Documentation of vaccination status must be shown with a school ID, passport or driver's license (for those 16 and up) upon entry to any venue and available upon request at any time.

## Health & Safety Requirements for Participation

*As of September 22, 2021*

### **The following are acceptable as proof of vaccination:**

- A physical vaccination card (which includes name of person vaccinated, type of vaccine and date of last dose administered), OR
- A photo of a vaccination card as separate document, OR
- A photo of the attendee's vaccine card stored on a phone or electronic device, OR
- Documentation of vaccination from a healthcare provider electronic health record or state [Immunization Information System record](#).

*\*Note: Matching photo ID (such as driver's license, passport or school ID) required at check in at every venue. Children without a photo ID must be accompanied by a guardian. There will be no separate sections for vaccinated/unvaccinated participants or concert attendees.*

### **PROOF OF NEGATIVE COVID-19 PCR TEST**

Participants not vaccinated, including children in the audience under age 12, are required to show proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test result dated from within 48 hours prior to arrival at honors registration.

### **The following are acceptable as proof of negative COVID-19 test result:**

- Printed document from the test provider or laboratory, OR
- An email or text message displayed on a phone or electronic device from the test provider or laboratory.

### **Additional information about negative COVID-19 test results:**

- The information provided needs to include name of person tested, type of test performed and date of negative PCR test result (date must be within 72 hours of entering the performance venue)
- Antigen tests cannot be accepted. Self-reported negative test results that are not from a test provider, a laboratory or a health care provider cannot be accepted.

*\*Note: Matching photo ID (such as driver's license, passport or school ID) required at check in at every venue. Children without a photo ID must be accompanied by a guardian. There will be no separate sections for vaccinated/unvaccinated participants or concert attendees.*
