GENERAL INFORMATION

COVID Information: Performance PPE/protocols are not required but should be used to the comfort level of the individual performer. Masking inside all UWM facilities is not required, but strongly encouraged for all. Social distancing of at least 3-ft. is strongly encouraged for all. To keep event numbers down, we suggest no more than 2 supporters in attendance per performer.

Festival Headquarters/Info Tables

Festival HQ is in MUSIC Rm. 130 (1st floor). General Information tables are in the Music Building and Mainstage Theatre lobby. These are areas for emergency contact (if needed) and general questions including lost and found.

NO Equipment Storage

*Note: **The following are NOT PROVIDED:** Drum sets, PA systems, special lighting, choral risers, specialized tables for handbell choirs. Music Theatre vocalists must provide their own CD players.*

Parking and Unloading

Buses may unload students along Downer Avenue, Kenwood Boulevard and Hartford Avenue. We recommend bus parking on Lake Drive east of campus. General parking is available on neighborhood streets to the east and north of the campus and south of the Zelazo Building. **Parking meters and restrictions are in effect so respect those areas marked for NO PARKING or short-term parking only.**

Equipment for swing choir or jazz ensembles can be unloaded in the small parking lot on the east end of the music building. Enter a long drive from Downer Ave. (keep your eyes open for exiting vehicles) between Mitchell Hall (red brick) and Curtin Hall (tall cement structure). Short-term meters are in effect in this lot. **You must load/unload and then move your vehicle immediately.**

Schedules

WSMA created the schedule for this State Festival honoring requests as possible. If conflicts remain, the largest group from within the same school should have priority. Please inform door monitors if delays are anticipated. Directors may switch performance event times within their own school's entries in a specific room by notifying the door monitor, but it is NOT possible to change rooms.
