BUSES may unload students in the circle drive near the Student Center on Parkside Boulevard – OR in the circle drive in front of the Rita Tallent Picken Regional Center for Arts & Humanities. Buses must park in the Tallent Hall lot on the EAST side of the campus. *See campus map for details.*
