GENERAL INFORMATION

Headquarters

Festival Headquarters is located in the Truman T. Lowe Center for the Arts, Room 122 and 124. This room can be found past the lobby and windows of the Art Gallery, left at the end of the hallway.

Schedules

Wisconsin School Music Association (WSMA) created the schedule for this Festival and did its very best to honor emergency time requests and avoid conflicts, whenever possible. If conflicts remain, the largest group from within the same school should take priority. Please inform room monitors if delays are anticipated. Directors may switch event performance times within their own school's entries, scheduled in the same room, by notifying the room monitor, but it is NOT permissible to change rooms.

Parking

Due to construction, parking will be different in 2024. Teachers, performers, and their families may park in the Parking Garage located on La Crosse Street. Parking for participants will be located in the Parking Garage on La Crosse Street between 16th and 17th. From there, signs will direct you to Centennial Hall and the Truman T. Lowe Center for the Arts.

From North/East: *Use Losey Blvd to La Crosse Street to park in garage and to access Festival Sites via signage. ***Buses:** Buses can park in spaces around the parking ramp on 16th and 17th Streets on the north side of UWL's campus. If buses have trouble finding a parking space, please call dispatch at (608) 789-9000.

Results Posting

Official results will also be posted within 48 hours at www.wsmamusic.org. Directors may pick up completed adjudicator forms, in the Festival Headquarters (122), after the last results for the school have been posted. Envelopes not retrieved will be mailed directly to the school from the WSMA office.

Warm-Up Rooms

Do not leave instruments or other belongings unattended in warm-up rooms, hallways, or performance sites. Participants are responsible for their own belongings. Practice rooms (with pianos) are available in the basement of the Lowe Center for the Arts. There will be an additional warm-up room available in Centennial (please see signage posted the day of the event). Music stands will be provided in warm-up rooms. UWL will try to provide keyboards for some of the warm-up rooms.
