**Parking**

All Buses should unload students and equipment, then park in Lots Q, P, T or V.

Automobiles may park in any university parking lot. Please note: The Fine Arts Center is one block from a fire station, and parking regulations are strictly enforced. Buses or automobiles parked on the wrong side of the street will be ticketed by the City of Stevens Point Police Department.
