FESTIVAL HEADQUARTERS:

Festival Headquarters is located in Room 180 (Performing and Visual Arts Office) of Doudna Hall, which is located at the east end of the building.

BUS PARKING:

Please use lot 6 located in parking area of Hickory Street and Irene Street. Once that lot is full, buses will need to park off campus.

UNLOADING INSTRUMENTS AND EQUIPMENT

Instruments and equipment may be unloaded in the circle drive at the front of the Center for the Arts. Trucks and trailers should then park on the street or in the parking area on Hickory and Greenwood Ave. **Parking in the Center for the Arts loading dock area is not permitted as per campus police orders.** Campus police will assist you in finding parking for trailers.

FESTIVAL SCHEDULE:

Wisconsin School Music Association (WSMA) created the schedule for this state festival. WSMA did its very best to honor emergency time requests and avoid conflicts wherever possible. If conflicts remain, the largest group from within the same school should have priority. Please inform room monitors if delays are anticipated. Performers or teachers CANNOT change rooms. Directors are asked to provide notification to WSMA about any cancellations.

RESULTS POSTING:

Unofficial results will be posted on the WSMA website (wsmamusic.org) and updated approximately every two hours. Directors ONLY may pick up completed adjudication forms after the last results for the school have been **posted and recorded** at Festival Headquarters. Results not retrieved will be scanned and emailed from the WSMA office the week following the festival. Result packets will be mailed upon request.
